- ✓ In each city, there must be in any one session a minimum of **ten (10)** candidates as per Cambridge ESOL Guidelines for Minimum Entries - Cambridge ESOL examinations.
- ✓ Candidates must sit all the tests for any of the exams in the same city and in the same session.
- ✓ Applications for Special Arrangements must be made at the time of enrolment with recent documentation (within 2 years).
- ✓ Once entered **candidates cannot transfer** from one exam level to another, **cannot defer their entry** from one examination session to another and **cannot withdraw & automatically receive a refund**. Partial refunds may be given in case of illness substantiated by a medical certificate at the discretion of The Centre Exams Manager.
